### Face Painting Design Visualize the End Product

The first thing to remember is that one ought to value one's choice of paint. Buying manufactured face paints would be a lot cheaper than buying professional face paint or stage makeup. Secondly, use a sponge in order to apply the paint when thinking of covering a large area or putting a base color on.

One should also remain patient and allow the paint to dry before applying a second coat. Applying thin layers is preferable to applying one thick layer since thick layers are prone to crack.
